
About the Summit



The Barbara Starfield Primary Care Leadership Award

The PCC established the Barbara Starfield Primary Care Leadership Award in 2012 to honor Dr. Starfield, recognizing her enduring commitment to the philosophy that all individuals should receive comprehensive, coordinated, and personfocused care. The award is presented annually to an individual or organization that demonstrates exceptional work toward advancing the goals of primary care and, in particular, a strong commitment to person-focused care.

The Primary Care Community Leadership Award

This award honors an individual or organization that has demonstrated remarkable leadership to ensure that primary care is foundational to community or state health care reform efforts.

The Advanced Primary Care Practice Award

This award is presented to an organization that is an extraordinary primary care practice. This practice serves as a model for transformation through innovation as reflected in the <u>Shared Principles of Primary Care</u>, including patient- and family-centered, team-based care and high value.

The David Meyers Research Award

This award was established in 2023 to honor and advance the legacy of Dr. David Meyers, a primary care physician and leader in health policy research.
